Does Mozambique have a 5G network?

Dimension Data Mozambique extends its satellite service to Mozambique using OneWeb's constellation of 648 LEO satellites. Vodacom Mozambique launches the first commercial 5G services in the country. Mozambique Telecom progresses with the second phase of its network modernisation program.

Where will 5G be deployed in Mozambique?

The telco's CEO, Nuno Quelhas stated that 5G would help improve the quality of life and promote the growth of the youthful population. "5G would help to expand financial inclusion in Mozambique, as the aim is to cover 75% of the adult Mozambican population by 2025 and make payments through M-Pesa available anywhere in the country," he added.
