A full container load (FCL) is where the shipment is to be the only one in a container. Smaller ocean freight shipments, that will be consolidated with other shipments in a container, are called less than a container load (LCL). What fees are included in a container delivery service?

All fees up to destination container yard including origin land delivery, transshipments, surcharges, ocean or air freight, terminal handling charges (THCs) and destination terminal forwarding are inside. Door/free out. Carrier organizes delivery from shipper's warehouse to destination terminal.
